Walks & Visits - Summer 2019

- 13th May** **Museum of London. You can join a group, or wander with other MHLHG members. Meet outside St. Paul's underground at 10.50am (Cafe Nero entrance) for the short walk to the Museum of London. Optional visit to the Barbican Centre afterwards for coffee. Free**
- 20th May** **A walk outside of Greenwich Park with John Goodier. Meet at 10.45am at entrance to Foot Tunnel in Greenwich (Close to the Cutty Sark). £4**
- 27th May** **Bank Holiday**

- 10th June** **Women's Suffrage 1866-1918 walk in Greenwich and Blackheath. Led by local historian Dr Ann Dingsdale. This is a leisurely Story Walk. It starts at Greenwich Station and ends at Blackheath Station. It lasts 1 ½ to 2hrs. The trail includes some gentle uphill walking. Meet at Greenwich Station forecourt at 10.30am. (inside ticket hall if damp) access by DLR, Thameslink South Eastern etc buses include 177, 180, 386 £4**
- 20th June THURSDAY**
Visit to Charterhouse for guided tour. Tour booked for 11.30am. Meet at St. Paul's underground (cafe Nero entrance) at 10.45am to walk together to Charterhouse. £10 per person. Maximum number 20
